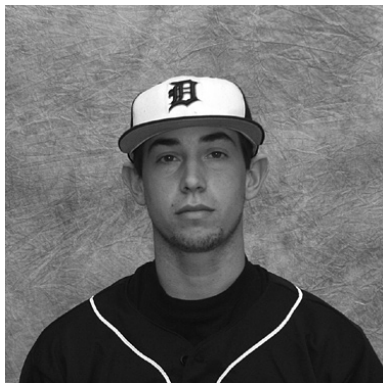
Scott Payne
